CRITERIUM STAGE: Please note the following corrections or updates to the Technical Guide:

ALL CATEGORIES - Free Laps: The Downtown Criterium will be on a 1k course. The free lap rule will be in effect until eight laps to go. Pit officials will determine whether a free lap is to be awarded or denied. Free laps will only be awarded for legitimate mishaps. 3H6(c)

Riders who suffer a mishap after free laps have expired will have to immediately decide:

- if they wish to chase without receiving a free lap and receive the time of the group they were with and race for their actual place across the finish line, unless pulled from the race.
- If they decide not to continue, they will receive the time of the main bunch they were with at the time of the mishap and will be placed after riders completing the distance of the race.

Riders who are in danger of being overtaken in the criterium (about 80% behind the leader of the lap) will be removed from the race and given prorated times. 3H6(g)(ii)

Time Limit:

Men Pro-1, Women Pro-1-2, Men 2: 50% of the race distance before being withdrawn by the officials at "80% down".

Amateur: No time limit. Times will be calculated for riders withdrawn by the officials at "80% down".

ALL CATEGORIES - Numbers: Numbers must be placed as shown in the picture in the Technical Guide - RIGHT side parallel with and above the side seam.



Men Pro-1 and Women Pro-1-2:

Sprints: Sprint points will be awarded first to riders having completed the farthest distance in the race, then by order across the finish line.

Women Pro-1-2: Intermediate at about 15, 25, and 35 minutes; points (3,2,1)

Men Pro-1: Intermediate at about 20, 40, and 60 minutes; points (3,2,1)

Both: Finish: 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
